Re: Notice of Order against Gantry Trucking Ltd. ("Gantry") and TSD Holding Inc. ("TSD") to Comply with the *Container Trucking Act* (the "*Act*") and Container Trucking Services Licence (the "*Licence*")

The Office of the BC Container Trucking Commissioner (OBCCTC) is conducting an audit of Gantry Trucking Ltd. and TSD Holding Inc. ("Gantry/TSD"). On November 21, 2016, an OBCCTC auditor requested that Gantry/TSD provide evidence to identify drivers who worked less than 2340 hours in the drayage industry and provide daily trip sheets, time sheets, and pay cheque stubs with respect to two drivers, Ricky Akali and Balwinder Sohal, for the periods June 1 to December 31, 2015 and March 1 to October 31, 2016. This material was to be supplied by November 25, 2016.

You have replied to the auditor on November 21, 2016, advising that the requested information would be provided by the due date; however, no further correspondence or records have been received by the auditor to date.

By this Order, I am directing Gantry/TSD to produce the requested evidence and records by January 11, 2017. Failure to comply with this Order will be viewed as serious non-compliance with the *Act*, and available penalties under the *Act* include suspension or cancellation of Gantry Trucking Ltd. and TSD Holding Inc.'s licenses and the imposition of penalties of up to \$500,000. This Order will be published as required by Section 11 of the *Act*. This Order does not constitute notice of penalty pursuant to section 34 of the *Act*. However, if there is not compliance with this Order, subsequent notices of penalty will be issued.
