Container Trucking Services Licence 2017/18

The current 2016/17 Container Trucking Services (CTS) Licence expires on May 31, 2017 while the Vancouver Fraser Port Authority Access Agreements will continue in effect for the remainder of their respective pre-determined Term (2-years or 4-years).

This year, the Office of the BC Container Trucking Commissioner (OBCCTC) is offering all CTS Licence holders who intend to retain a CTS Licence and Access Agreement, the opportunity to extend the Term of their current licences for another year. Except for an amendment to the Term of the CTS Licence, all other terms and conditions of each extended CTS Licence will remain unchanged including the number of Truck Tags allocated to each licence as of May 31, 2017.


In the interest of ensuring ongoing industry stability, the OBCCTC will not be inviting applications for new licences this year.

During the week of April 3, 2017, on behalf of the OBCCTC, the Vancouver Fraser Port Authority will forward a simplified Licence/amending package to all TLS Program participating companies. TLS carriers must carefully review and verify the package contents and return the documents to the TLS Program Administration Department by the deadline date provided as part of the package.
