Dear Mr. Brar:

**Re: Notice of Order against A-Can Transport Ltd. (“A-Can”) to Comply with the *Container Trucking Act* (the “Act”) and Container Trucking Services Licence (the “Licence”)**

The Office of the BC Container Trucking Commissioner (OBCCTC) is conducting an audit of A-Can. On July 20, 2017, the OBCCTC requested specific records for each driver that worked for A-Can during the months of November 2014 and March 2017. To date, A-Can has only provided the requested records for March 2017.

By this Order, I am directing A-Can to produce the requested November 2014 records by November 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2017. Failure to comply with this Order will be viewed as serious non-compliance with the *Act*, and available penalties under the *Act* include suspension or cancellation of A-Can’s licence and the imposition of penalties of up to \$500,000. This Order will be published as required by Section 11 of the *Act*. This Order does not constitute notice of penalty pursuant to section 34 of the *Act*. However, if there is not compliance with this Order, subsequent notices of penalty will be issued.
