We write this memo to draw the attention of TLS licence holders to their obligations under the National Safety Code (the "NSC"), which is a set of national safety, management and performance standards supported in BC by Commercial Vehicle Safety and Enforcement ("CVSE"). The requirements of the NSC can be found at:
