Vacant Independent Operator Tag Bulletin

In accordance with the Office of the BC Container Trucking Commissioner's (OBCCTC) October 19, 2016 Interim Truck Tag Policy Notice of Intent Bulletin, the OBCCTC has begun assessing Independent Operator Truck Tags which have remained vacant for longer than forty-five days following termination of a Sponsorship Agreement and are subject to reallocation by the Commissioner.

Further to the October 19, 2016 Bulletin, this Bulletin advises all licence holders and Independent Operators that the forty-five day period during which licensees or Independent Operators may fill a vacant truck tag or find new sponsorship, begins effective the date of sponsorship termination. This date may be confirmed by the OBCCTC through either written evidence of termination (i.e. a dated and signed letter of resignation or termination) and/or by confirmation to the OBCCTC of the termination date by the effected Independent Operator.
