On September 25, 2017, I issued a Decision to Sunlover Holding Co. Ltd. ("Sunlover") in which I Ordered Sunlover to:

 a. comply with the Sunlover #1 Order and the Deputy Commissioner's Order, and pay forthwith, and in any event no later than October 10th, 2017, the 22 Company Drivers owed \$10,322.75 for container trucking services performed between December 22nd, 2014 and July 31st, 2016;

- b. pay forthwith, and in any event no later than October 10th, 2017, the wait time payment amounts totaling \$2,510.00 owing to I/O's; and
- c. meet with an auditor by no later than October 10th, 2017 and provide to the auditor evidence that bank drafts have been provided to each driver owed money under this Order along with a breakdown of the bank draft amount for each driver.

At that time, Sunlover was advised that Container Trucking Services Licence No. 60040(2016) would be suspended effective October 10th, 2017 and remain suspended until such time as Sunlover complies with the above Orders. In addition to the above Orders, Sunlover was further ordered to:

- a. pay forthwith, and in any event no later than October 25th, 2017, the amounts totaling \$23,996.75 found by the auditor to be owing to I/O's and Company Drivers as a result of missed payroll; and
- b. meet with an auditor by no later than October 25th, 2017and provide to the auditor evidence that bank drafts have been provided to each driver owed money under this Order along with a breakdown of the bank draft amount for each driver.

I am advised by the Office of the BC Container Trucking Commissioner's (OBCCTC) auditor that Sunlover has complied with my September 25, 2017 Orders and paid all monies owing to its drivers under this Decision (\$36,829.50). This letter is notice that the proposed suspension penalty in CTC Decision No. 22/2017 is withdrawn and Sunlover's CTS Licence will not be suspended. This letter will be published on the CTC website.
