Container Trucking Services Licence 2018

The current 2017/18 Container Trucking Services (CTS) Licence expires on June 30, 2018 while the Vancouver Fraser Port Authority Access Agreements will continue in effect for the remainder of their respective pre-determined Term (2-years or 4-years).

This year, the Office of the BC Container Trucking Commissioner (OBCCTC) is offering all CTS Licence holders who intend to retain a CTS Licence and Access Agreement, the opportunity to extend the Term of their current licences for another two years.

In the interest of ensuring ongoing industry stability, the OBCCTC will not be inviting applications for new licences this year.

During the week of April 30, 2018, on behalf of the OBCCTC, the Vancouver Fraser Port Authority will forward a simplified licence application package to all TLS Program participating companies. TLS carriers must carefully review and verify the package contents, sign all required forms and return the documents to the TLS Program Administration Department by the deadline date provided as part of the package. More information will be provided with the package.

Effective May 1, 2018, additional truck tag requests made under the OBCCTC's Truck Tag Management Policy will not be accepted until July 1, 2018 (the end of the licensing period). However, additional truck tag requests can be made when submitting the licence application package.
