CTS Licence Tag Management Policy – I/O List

Request for Applications

On February 14, 2019, the Office of the BC Container Trucking Commissioner (“OBCCTC”) issued a Bulletin advising there are vacant I/O truck tags across licensed companies that cannot be filled by I/Os on the I/O List.

This Bulletin is notice to all stakeholders that the Commissioner will add **20 new Eligible I/Os** to the I/O List. Applicants must complete an application and demonstrate that they meet the following criteria:

- 5 (five) or more years of experience in providing local drayage and/or long haul (highway) container trucking services; and
- Was not a company employee of a Licence holder in the three months prior to being placed on the I/O list.

Applicants must also declare that they are aware of and will meet the following conditions within 30 days of receiving written confirmation they have been added to the list:

- Acquire a compliant vehicle that meets or exceeds the Vancouver Fraser Port Authority (“VFPA”) truck age requirement;
- Secure a Sponsorship/Joinder agreement with a Licensee that has a vacant tag; and
- Obtain VFPA Truck Licensing System approval.

Should the number of eligible applications exceed the number of advertised spaces, successful applicants will be determined by a lottery. All applicants, both successful and unsuccessful, will be advised of their status in writing.

Applications will be accepted until **4:00 PM on March 29th, 2019** and must be sent to the OBCCTC at the following email address: Registrar@obcctc.ca. Late applications will not be accepted.
