Container Trucking Services Licence 2020

The current Container Trucking Services (CTS) Licence expires on June 30, 2020 while the Vancouver Fraser Port Authority Access Agreements will continue in effect for the remainder of their respective pre-determined Term.

A revised licensing scheme and truck tag policy was to be introduced in July 2020 with the application process for new licences to begin in April 2020.

The Covid-19 global pandemic impacts everyone and at this time it is particularly important that supply chains continue to function. Licensed companies and truck drivers in the Lower Mainland's drayage sector are a vital link in the supply chain and their focus must remain on the services they perform.

In the interest of ensuring ongoing industry stability, the Office of the BC Container Trucking Commissioner (OBCCTC) is immediately suspending the 2020 CTS Licence process and will not be inviting applications for new licences at this time.

The OBCCTC continues to monitor the response to Covid-19 and will amend the 2020 CTS Licence process timeline as required. This may include extending the current licence beyond its June 2020 expiry date. Further information about the extension of the current licence will be issued at a later date.
