## Container Trucking Services Licence Amendment – June 2020

The current 2018/20 Container Trucking Services (CTS) Licence expires on June 30, 2020 while the Vancouver Fraser Port Authority Access Agreements will continue in effect for the remainder of their respective pre-determined term.

On March 18, 2020, the Office of the BC Container Trucking Commissioner (OBCCTC) suspended the 2020 CTS Licence application process in light of COVID-19 and advised licensees that the current licence may be extended beyond its June 2020 expiry date.

The current **CTS Licence Term has now been extended until November 30, 2020**. Except for an amendment to the Term of the CTS Licence, all other terms and conditions of each extended CTS Licence will remain unchanged including the number of Truck Tags allocated to each licence as of June 30, 2020.

Subject to further unforeseen circumstances, the 2020 CTS Licence application process will begin during the week of July 6, 2020. At that time, the OBCCTC will release a licence application package. Licensees must carefully review and verify the package contents, fill out and sign all required forms and return the documents to the OBCCTC by the deadline date provided as part of the application package. More information will be provided with the package.

New CTS Licences will be effective December 1, 2020.
