Off Dock Drayage Insights Report Published

On May 25, 2020 the Office of the British Columbia Container Trucking Commissioner (OBCCTC) issued a bulletin advising stakeholders that the OBCCTC and the Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure were exploring opportunities to improve fairness, stability, efficiency and competitiveness in the Vancouver Gateway, specifically related to off-dock container movements.

Cascadia Partners was tasked with preparing a report intended to help better understand the flows of off-dock container movements in order to inform policies and decision making.
