## Off-Dock Drayage Insights Report - Submission Date Extended

On September 23, 2020 the Office of the British Columbia Container Trucking Commissioner (OBCCTC) issued a Bulletin calling for submissions from stakeholders regarding the <a href="Off-Dock">Off-Dock</a> <a href="Drayage Insight Report">Drayage Insight Report</a> prepared by Cascadia Partners.

As outlined in the Bulletin, the report was prepared to help better understand the flows of off-dock container movements in order to inform policies and decision making in order to improve fairness, stability, efficiency and competitiveness in the Vancouver Gateway.

The closing date for written feedback regarding the report was October 31, 2020. Specifically, the OBCCTC would like input with a specific focus on the following:

- What container movements should be regulated?;
- What rates should apply to those container movements?; and
- Options for enforcement.
