As you already know, the OBCCTC wrapped up last year by issuing 2020 CTS Licences. For this new year, the OBCCTC will be focusing on improving our processes to better serve different stakeholders.

First off, we will be making changes to our overall communication efforts. Industry advisories will now be published to inform CTS Licence holders of important audit and enforcement information relevant to their operations and practices. ## **Industry Advisory - Dead Runs**

Dead runs are when one container is moved from one location to another, even if the destination is not its intended location. As a result, trip rate drivers must be paid for all container moves.

## RECENT DECISIONS

In **Safeway Trucking Ltd. / Coast Pacific Carrier Inc. (No. 11/2020)**, the OBCCTC investigated a complaint from a driver regarding payment owed for container trucking services performed following an order from the Civil Resolution Tribunal. The companies have now paid the driver the money owed. A penalty of \$15,000 was issued.

In **Can American Enterprises Ltd. (No. 12/2020)**, the company was found to have not paid I/Os for trips performed and did not retain proper records for trips completed. The company was ordered to calculate and pay the amount of money owing. A penalty of \$10,000 was issued, as well as a proposal to suspend the company's licence if they failed to pay the money owing.

In **Harbour Link Container Services Inc. (No. 13/2020)**, the company failed to pay correct rates to some drivers and did not pay a regulated trip rate for dead runs and short haul trips. The company also failed to keep proper records for each trucker. A penalty of \$1,500 was issued, and the company was ordered to pay money owing to drivers.

## DID YOU KNOW?

### **Help us help you!**

In order for the OBCCTC to best help you with your complaints, we need evidence to support and pursue further action. Make sure you keep a record of any documents you sign, such as taking photos, and keep track of your own trips and hours worked. This will make it easier for us to help you get paid properly.

### **Cash back is not allowed**

Under no circumstances should drivers be asked to give cash back to their employers from their pay cheques. If you are asked to give cash back to your employer, make sure you keep evidence of this so that the OBCCTC can help you.

### **Dead runs payment**

Drivers need to be paid full rate payments for dead runs. If you make a dead run, record your trip and make sure you are paid full rates for the trips.

### **Know your trip rates**

The OBCCTC has a Trip Rates Booklet to help make sure that you are paid the correct rates for both on-dock and off-dock container movements. You can always download and print a copy to verify that you are being paid correctly.
