2020 CTS Licence Bulletin #2 – Sponsorship Agreement

This is the Office of the BC Container Trucking Commissioner's (OBCCTC) second bulletin in its 2020 CTS Licence Bulletin series. In this Bulletin, licensees are reminded about important changes to the Sponsorship Agreement.

IO List

Section 4 of the Sponsorship Agreement requires sponsored IOs to be on the Commissioner's IO List.

Licensees must ensure that IOs are on the Commissioner's IO List and eligible to be sponsored. IOs that are not on the Commissioner's IO List cannot be sponsored. Please contact the OBCCTC to confirm that the driver is indeed on the Commissioner's IO list.

Indirectly Employed Operators (IO employees)

Section 5 of the Sponsorship Agreement requires licensees to list all employees of sponsored IOs. Licensees must advise the OBCCTC of any changes to the information listed under their Licence.

Section 6 of the Sponsorship Agreement prohibits a sponsored IO from employing more than one person at a time to undertake Container Trucking Services on their behalf.

Record Keeping

Section 8 of the Sponsorship Agreement requires that all information submitted to the Commissioner by the licensee regarding Sponsorship Agreements be kept current. It is the licensee's obligation to notify the Commissioner right away if any sponsorship information changes.

Licensees are reminded that breach of the 2020 CTS Licence conditions may result in an administrative penalty.
