2020 CTS Licence Bulletin #3 - Licences & Truck Tags

This is the Office of the BC Container Trucking Commissioner's (OBCCTC) third bulletin in its 2020 CTS Licence Bulletin series. In this Bulletin, licensees are reminded about the Licence and truck tags.

Truck Tags

Section 6.9 of the Licence requires licensees to assign a truck tag to each truck performing container trucking services (on and off-dock work).

All trucks performing container trucking services for a CTS Licence holder must have a truck tag assigned to the truck. Please ensure that truck and driver information registered with the OBCCTC is up to date.

Licence and Truck Tag Assignment or Transfer

Section 6.19 of the Licence prohibits licensees from assigning or transferring a Licence or truck tags.

Section 6.20 of the Licence does not allow licensees to receive by assignment or transfer a Licence or truck tags.

Licences and truck tags are granted to a company by the Commissioner and cannot be moved or transferred between companies. Licensees must not accept or receive assignments or transfers of a Licence or truck tags.

Licensees are reminded that breach of the 2020 CTS Licence conditions may result in an administrative penalty.
