CTS Licence Truck Tag Management Policy Additional Independent Operator (I/O) Truck Tags Applications

The Office of the BC Container Trucking Commissioner ("OBCCTC") is redistributing seven vacant I/O truck tags.

Under section 6 of the CTS Licence Truck Tag Management Policy, the OBCCTC can issue truck tags to licensees throughout the term of the Licence at its discretion and in exceptional circumstances.

The OBCCTC is aware that some licensees have used untagged trucks for off-dock container movements in violation of the CTS Licence and that the use of tagged trucks that primarily or exclusively perform off-dock container moves can have a negative impact a licensee's ability to manage on-dock fleet capacity.

In these exceptional circumstances, the OBCCTC has determined that it is appropriate to redistribute I/O truck tags that have been returned to the OBCCTC.

Effective immediately, licensees that are not currently under audit or investigation and can demonstrate a business need for additional I/O truck tags are invited to submit an application for additional I/O truck tags.

The additional I/O truck tags application must:

- Be submitted using the form posted on the <u>OBCCTC website</u>.
- Include a business case clearly outlining:
 - why the licensee is unable to meet their business needs with the current allotment of truck tags specifically demonstrating how the use of tagged trucks to perform off-dock container trucking services is impacting on-dock fleet capacity;
 - what measures, if any, the licensee has taken to address business need with its current truck tag allotment (i.e. outsourcing, slip seating etc.); and
 - how the Licensee plans to incorporate the additional I/O truck tags into their fleet and the expected impact on their ability to meet current and future business needs.
- Specify the number of I/O truck tags requested. **Applications for company truck tags will not be accepted.**
- Be received by the OBCCTC on or before May 19, 2021.
