## CTS Licence Truck Tag Management Policy The Commissioner's Independent Operator (I/O) List

On June 2, 2021 the Office of the BC Container Trucking Commissioner (OBCCTC) issued a bulletin advising stakeholders that eight vacant I/O truck tags had been redistributed to companies that had successfully demonstrated a business case for additional I/O truck tags. Licensees are required to fill the vacant truck tags by sponsoring I/Os on the Commissioner's I/O List.

I/Os were invited to contact the OBCCTC to inquire about which companies have vacant truck tags. The OBCCTC has received 44 queries from interested drivers, 31 of whom are not on the Commissioner's I/O List

This bulletin is a reminder to all stakeholders that the Commissioner is not adding names to the I/O List at this time. Only I/Os currently on the I/O List may be sponsored by a licensee with a vacant I/O truck tag.
