CTS Licence Truck Tag Management Policy Additional Independent Operator (I/O) Truck Tag Applications Being Accepted

Over the past few months, the Office of the BC Container Trucking Commissioner has redistributed several I/O truck tags to licensees that have demonstrated, through an application process, they had work for drivers. An additional seven I/O truck tags have recently been returned to the OBCCTC.

The OBCCTC will reallocate these seven I/O truck tags and is once again inviting licensees to apply for the I/O truck tags.

Licensees that applied for I/O truck tags during the previous calls for applications **are not** required to submit a new application but are invited to submit an expression of interest that indicates the number of I/O truck tags requested. Previous applicants may supply any additional documentation in support of their expression of interest.

New applicants will be required to complete and submit the I/O Truck Tag Application posted on the OBCCTC website.

In accordance with the Truck Tag Management Policy, licensees that are currently under audit or investigation are not eligible to apply.
