Call for Submissions – CTS Licence Amendments

The Office of the British Columbia Container Trucking Commissioner (OBCCTC) has published the CTS Licence Amendments Consultation Guide and is inviting stakeholders to submit written comments on the amendments outlined in the guide.

The consultation guide outlines the amendments that will be made to the CTS Licence (Licence), including a two-year extension to the term of the current Licence, a prohibition on sub-contracting with unlicensed companies for container trucking services and the introduction of electronic record keeping obligations.

When submitting comments, please use the guide and consider answering the included questions to keep feedback focused.

The deadline to submit comments is the end of day on May 27, 2022. Please email your submissions to registrar@obcctc.ca. All stakeholders are encouraged to comment, including drivers, licensees and associations.

Following the comment period, the Commissioner will hold meetings with stakeholders before preparing a final consultation report.
