Re: Pro West Trucking Ltd. – Audit

As the auditor has identified instances of potential trip splitting in the audit periods of August 2018 and September 2019 in contravention of s. 23 of the *Act*, and as Pro West's records have now been returned to it, I have revised my Order as follows:

Pro West Trucking Ltd. must review the auditor's calculations of amounts owing to I/Os for August 2018 and September 2019 (where all instances of possible trip splitting were noted), work with the auditor to make any required changes to the auditor's calculations for the August 2018 and September 2019 audit periods, and use the auditor's revised calculations for the August 2018 and September 2019 audit periods to conduct a full audit of its records for the period between December 1, 2016 and December 31, 2021 to determine a total amount owing. This must be completed within 60 days from the date of this letter.

Failure to comply with this Order will be viewed as serious non-compliance with the *Act*. Available penalties under the *Act* include suspension or cancellation of Pro West's licence and the imposition of penalties up to \$500,000.00.

This Order will be published on the OBCCTC website as required by section 11 of the *Act*. This Order does not constitute notice of penalty pursuant to section 34 of the *Act*. However, if your client does not comply with the Order, subsequent notices of penalty may also be issued.
