United Coastal Logistics Ltd. (CTC Decision No. 01/2023) – Decision Notice

In *United Coastal Logistics Decision*. (CTC Decision No. 01/2023) (the “Original Decision”), I found the licensee United Coastal Logistics. (“UCL”) paid one (1) driver less than the required minimum hourly rate, failed to pay eighteen (18) drivers the appropriate trip rate between July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2019 when it misidentified the proper geographic location of one of its customers.

In the Original Decision, I determined that this was an appropriate case to issue a penalty for the reasons set out in paragraphs 22-29 and proposed an administrative fine of \$25,000.00. Consistent with s. 34(2) of the Container Trucking Act (the “Act”), I advised UCL that I would consider its written response to the proposed penalty if it was received within 7 days.

UCL did not provide a written response to the proposed penalty.

In the result, I hereby order UCL to pay an administrative fine in the amount of \$7,000.00. Section 35(2) of the Container Trucking Act requires that this fine be paid within 30 days of the issuance of this Notice. Payments should be made by delivering to the Office of the BC Container Trucking Commissioner (“OBCCTC”) a cheque in the amount of \$7,000.00 to the Minister of Finance.

Finally, I note that UCL may request a reconsideration of the Commissioner’s Decision by filing a Notice of Reconsideration with the Commissioner not more than 30 days after UCL’s receipt of the Decision Notice. A Notice of Reconsideration must be:


- a) Made in writing,
- b) Identify the decision for which reconsideration is requested,
- c) State why the decision should be changed,
- d) State the outcome requested,
- e) Include the name and address for delivery, and telephone number of the applicant and, if the applicant is represented by counsel, include the full name, address for delivery and telephone number of the applicant’s counsel,
- f) Signed by the applicant or the applicant’s counsel.

Despite the filing of a Notice of Reconsideration, the above orders remain in effect until the reconsideration application is determined.
