Triangle Transportation Ltd. (CTC Decision No. 15/2024) – Decision Notice

In [Triangle Transportation Ltd.](#) (CTC Decision No. 15/2024) (“Commissioner’s Decision”) I determined that Triangle Transportation Ltd. (“Triangle”) had not paid some of its drivers the required minimum rates pursuant to section 24 of the *Container Trucking Regulation* (the “*Regulation*”) and failed to properly install its trucks with electronic tracking equipment and failed to pay maintain electronically generated payroll records for one year.

I ordered Triangle to, within 30 days of the date of the Commissioner’s Decision, pay its drivers \$1,752.80 and to review its payroll records for June 2023 to ensure compliance with the Rate Order. I also determined that this was an appropriate case to issue a penalty for the reasons set out in paragraphs 19-24. Consistent with s. 34(2) of the *Container Trucking Act*, I proposed to impose an administrative fine against Triangle in the amount of \$8,000.00 and advised Triangle that I would consider its written response to the proposed penalty if it was received within 7 days.

Triangle provided the Office of the BC Container Trucking Commissioner (“OBCCTC”) with a cheque in the amount of \$8,000.00 but has not provided a written response within the time specified in the notice.

Subsections 34(3) and (4) of the *Container Trucking Act* authorize the imposition of the proposed penalty after the licensee has had an opportunity to respond. Accordingly, hereby order Triangle to pay an administrative fine in the amount of \$8,000.00.

Finally, I note that Triangle may request a reconsideration of the Commissioner’s Decision by filing a Notice of Reconsideration with the Commissioner not more than 30 days after Triangle’s receipt of this Decision Notice. A Notice of Reconsideration must be:

- a. made in writing,
- b. identify the decision for which a reconsideration is requested,
- c. state why the decision should be changed,
- d. state the outcome requested,
- e. include the name, an address for delivery, and telephone number of the applicant and, if the applicant is represented by counsel, include the full name, address for delivery and telephone number of the applicant’s counsel,
- f. signed by the applicant or the applicant’s counsel.

Despite the filing of a Notice of Reconsideration, the above orders remain in effect until the reconsideration application is determined.

This decision notice along with the Commissioner's decision will be published on the Commissioner's website.
