Team Transport Services Ltd. (CTC Decision No 16/2024) – Decision Notice

In [Team Transport Services Ltd.](#) (CTC Decision No 16/2024), (“Commissioner’s Decision”) I determined that Burton Delivery Service Ltd. (“Burton”) failed to properly install its trucks with electronic tracking equipment and failed to pay maintain electronically generated payroll records for one year. I determine that this was an appropriate case to issue a penalty for the reasons set out in paragraphs 23-26.

On July 1, 2024, Burton amalgamated into Team Transport Services Ltd. (“Team Transport”). As the amalgamated company, Team Transport continues to be liable for the obligations of each amalgamating corporation as per s. 282(1)(h) of the BC Business Corporations Act.

I proposed to impose an administrative fine against Team Transport in the amount of \$6,000.00. Consistent with s. 34(2) of the Container Trucking Act, I advised Team Transport that I would consider its written response to the proposed penalty if it was received within 7 days.

Team Transport did not provide the Office of the BC Container Trucking Commissioner (“OBCCTC”) with a response within the specified timeframe.

In the result, I hereby order Team Transport to pay an administrative fine in the amount of \$6,000.00. Section 35(2) of the *Container Trucking Act* requires that this fine be paid within 30 days of the issuance of this Notice. Payment should be made by delivering to the Office of the BC Container Trucking Commissioner a cheque in the amount of \$6,000.00 payable to the Minister of Finance.

Finally, I note that Team Transport may request a reconsideration of the Commissioner’s Decision by filing a Notice of Reconsideration with the Commissioner not more than 30 days after Team Transport’s receipt of this Decision Notice. A Notice of Reconsideration must be:

- a. made in writing,
- b. identify the decision for which a reconsideration is requested,
- c. state why the decision should be changed,
- d. state the outcome requested,
- e. include the name, an address for delivery, and telephone number of the applicant and, if the applicant is represented by counsel, include the full name, address for delivery and telephone number of the applicant’s counsel,
- f. signed by the applicant or the applicant’s counsel.

Despite the filing of a Notice of Reconsideration, the above orders remain in effect until the reconsideration application is determined.

This decision notice along with the commissioner's decision will be published on the Commissioner's website.
