**Prudential Transportation Ltd. (CTC Decision No. 17/2025) – Decision Notice**

In [Prudential Transportation Ltd.](#) (CTC Decision No. 17/2025) (“Commissioner’s Decision”) I determined that Prudential Transportation Ltd. (“Prudential”) had failed to display a valid OBCCTC tag on a truck performing container trucking services as required by section 6.16 and 6.17 and section 1(d)(i) of Appendix B of its 2024 CTS licence.

I determined that this was an appropriate case to issue a penalty for the reasons set out beginning at paragraph 15. Consistent with s. 34(2) of the *Container Trucking Act*, I proposed an administrative fine of \$500.00 and advised Prudential that I would consider its written response to the proposed penalty if it was received within 7 days.

Prudential provided the Office of the BC Container Trucking Commissioner (“OBCCTC”) with a response within the specified timeframe, asking that the OBCCTC send an invoice for immediate payment of the penalty. The OBCCTC does not issue individual invoices, but I understand from Prudential’s response that it does not dispute the penalty proposed.

Subsections 34(3) and (4) of the *Container Trucking Act* authorize the imposition of the proposed penalty after the licensee has had an opportunity to respond. Accordingly, I hereby order Prudential to pay an administrative fine in the amount of \$500.00.

Section 35(2) of the *Act* requires this fine to be paid within 30 days of the issuance of this Decision Notice. Payment should be made by delivering to the OBCCTC a cheque in the amount of \$500.00 payable to the Minister of Finance.

Finally, I note that Prudential may request a reconsideration by filing a Notice of Reconsideration not more than 30 days after Prudential’s receipt of this Decision Notice. A Notice of Reconsideration must be:

- a. made in writing,
- b. identify the decision for which a reconsideration is requested,
- c. state why the decision should be changed,
- d. state the outcome requested,
- e. include the name, an address for delivery, and telephone number of the applicant and, if the applicant is represented by counsel, include the full name, address for delivery and telephone number of the applicant’s counsel,
- f. signed by the applicant or the applicant’s counsel.

Despite the filing of a Notice of Reconsideration, the above order remains in effect until the reconsideration application is determined.
