Super Star Trucking Ltd. (CTC Decision No. 04/2026) – Decision Notice

In [Super Star Trucking Ltd](#) (CTC Decision No. 04/2026) (“Supplemental Commissioner’s Decision”) I determined, pursuant to s. 2(3) of the *Container Trucking Act*, that Super Star Trucking Ltd (“Super Star”) was in breach of section 23 of the *Act* when it failed to pay the regulated rates to the Complainant between May 1, 2020 and March 16, 2024 and to its company drivers company drivers in the Audit Period (July and December 2023).

I determined that this was an appropriate case to issue a penalty for the reasons set out in paragraphs 20 to 29 of the Supplemental Commissioner’s Decision. Consistent with s. 34(2) of the *Container Trucking Act*, I proposed to impose an administrative fine against Super Star in the amount of \$110,000.00 and as suspension of its CTS licence to be served three days after the date of the decision notice for such time as it complies with the order set out in paragraph 30 b) or until November 30, 2026, whichever is sooner. I advised Super Star that I would consider its written response to the proposed penalty if it was received within 7 days.

I also ordered Super Star, pursuant to section 9 of the *Act*, to pay the drivers a total of \$23,030.14 as set out in Appendix A of the Supplemental Commissioner’s Decision and provide the auditor with payroll records (including unmodified wage statements) for the period of February 1, 2023 to January 31, 2024 (excluding July and December 2023) within 15 days of the decision.

On April 10, 2026, I received a request from counsel for Super Star for an update regarding its change of control application filed on March 16, 2026, but Super Star did not provide the Office of the BC Container Trucking Commissioner (“OBCCTC”) with a response to the proposed penalties within the specified timeframe. In addition, Super Star did not complete or provide compliance forms to the OBCCTC indicating that it had paid \$23,030.14 to the drivers and did not provide the payroll records as ordered by the deadline.

Subsections 34(3) and (4) of the *Container Trucking Act* authorize the imposition of the proposed penalty after the licensee has had an opportunity to respond. Accordingly, I hereby order Super Star to pay an administrative fine in the amount of \$110,000.00 and Super Star’s CTS licence will be suspended starting on **Thursday, April 30, 2026**, for such time as it complies with the order set out in paragraph 30 b) of the Supplemental Commissioner’s Decision or until November 30, 2026, whichever is sooner.

Section 35(2) of the *Act* requires this fine to be paid within 30 days of the issuance of this Decision Notice. Payment should be made by delivering to the OBCCTC a cheque in the amount of \$110,000.00 payable to the Minister of Finance.

As Super Star has not demonstrated it has paid \$23,030.14 to the drivers by the deadline, I have directed the registrar to realize Super Star's bond in the amount of \$23,030.14.

Finally, I note that Super Star may request a reconsideration of the Commissioner's Decision by filing a Notice of Reconsideration with the Commissioner not more than 30 days after Super Star's receipt of this Decision Notice. A Notice of Reconsideration must be:

- a. made in writing,
- b. identify the decision for which a reconsideration is requested,
- c. state why the decision should be changed,
- d. state the outcome requested,
- e. include the name, an address for delivery, and telephone number of the applicant and, if the applicant is represented by counsel, include the full name, address for delivery and telephone number of the applicant's counsel,
- f. signed by the applicant or the applicant's counsel.

Despite the filing of a Notice of Reconsideration, and subject to section 39(2) of the *Act*, the above order remains in effect until the reconsideration application is determined.
