### **Aquatrans Distributors Inc. (CTC Decision No. 07/2026) – Decision Notice**

In [Aquatrans Distributors Inc.](#) (CTC Decision No. 07/2026) (“Commissioner’s Decision”) I determined that Aquatrans Distributors Inc. (“Aquatrans”) failed to electronically track the number of hours of regulated work performed by its trucks and failed maintain electronically generated payroll records between December 2022 and April 2025 and therefore was in breach of sections 6.7 and 6.10 of its CTS licence.

I proposed to impose an administrative fine against Aquatrans the amount of \$6,000.00. Consistent with s. 34(2) of the *Act*, I advised Aquatrans that I would consider its written response to the proposed penalty if it was received within 7 days.

Aquatrans did not provide the Office of the BC Container Trucking Commissioner (“OBCCTC”) with a response within the specified timeframe.

In the result, I hereby order Aquatrans to pay an administrative fine in the amount of \$6,000.00.

Section 35(2) of the *Container Trucking Act* requires that this fine be paid within 30 days of the issuance of this Decision Notice. Payment should be made by delivering to the Office of the BC Container Trucking Commissioner a certified cheque or bank draft in the amount of \$6,000.00 payable to the Minister of Finance.

Finally, I note that Aquatrans may request a reconsideration by filing a Notice of Reconsideration with the Commissioner not more than 30 days after Aquatrans’s receipt of this Decision Notice. A Notice of Reconsideration must be:

- a. made in writing,
- b. identify the decision for which a reconsideration is requested,
- c. state why the decision should be changed,
- d. state the outcome requested,
- e. include the name, an address for delivery, and telephone number of the applicant and, if the applicant is represented by counsel, include the full name, address for delivery and telephone number of the applicant’s counsel,
- f. signed by the applicant or the applicant’s counsel.

Despite the filing of a Notice of Reconsideration, the above orders remain in effect until the reconsideration application is determined.

This decision notice along with the commissioner's decision will be published on OBCCTC's website.
