Driver Overtime Calculator - Now Available

The Office of the British Columbia Container Trucking Commissioner (OBCCTC) has released an overtime calculator to help Directly Employed Operators (company drivers) and Indirectly Employed Operators (IEOs) easily calculate daily and weekly overtime owed for performing regulated container trucking services in a work week.

The tool is straightforward and intuitive to use. Drivers simply input their name, hourly rate, and total daily hours worked each day (excluding unpaid breaks). The spreadsheet handles the rest to automatically calculate regular hours, daily overtime, weekly overtime, and estimated total wages.
